## Ryan's Journey

**Ryan started with ADTRAC in September 2019. He had no formal qualifications after moving from Spain at the point he was due to take his GCSE's. He had suffered with anxiety, due to his past experiences and wanted support with managing his anxiety. Ryan was very open to ideas and his goal was to build on his skills and qualifications and then to find work.**

The ADTRAC Mentor worked with Ryan on building up his confidence by meeting with him weekly in a location where he felt comfortable. Ryan also worked closely with our Mental Health Practitioner to help manage his anxiety.

As Ryan had no formal qualifications he and his mentor felt that this would be an excellent starting point. Ryan successfully completed whilst on ADTRAC a Level 3 First Aid in the Workplace qualification and with support he began building his CV.

As his ADTRAC Mentor got to know him it was realised that Ryan had a passion and a wealth of knowledge about War history, so they contacted the Royal Welsh Fusiliers museum in Caernarfon who were more than happy to take Ryan on as a volunteer, initially for one day a week. This was a very exciting opportunity for Ryan, as not only did he have a chance to share his knowledge by assisting with guided tours, but he will get to take part in a research project related to lost photographs of WW1 and WW2 veterans.

Utilising the fact that Ryan is fluent in Spanish, ADTRAC are in the process of speaking with a local language school for opportunities that may be suitable for him.

Ryan says that ADTRAC has really supported and helped him move forward towards his goal of finding employment. He now feels more confident when approaching employers, and feels he has a CV which shows his skills and experience.
