- Cyflwynodd y Cyfarwyddwr Gweithredol wybodaeth am Gynllun Twf Gogledd Cymru a thendr llwyddiannus £6.2m y Ganolfan Technoleg Bwyd a oedd yn cynnwys llinell gyllideb ar gyfer prosiectau strategol yng Nglynllifon.
- Cynghorodd cyngor y coleg pwyll wrth ystyried lleoliad adeilad newydd yng Nglynllifon, gan fod llawer o'r tir yn dir amaethyddol o safon uchel, a fyddai'n drueni ei golli.
- Cyflwynodd y Rheolwr Fferm a Choedwigaeth adroddiad a derbyniwyd adborth yr aelodau iddo.

Glynllifon – October 6, 2020

- The new management was welcomed to the meeting.
- The learner voice was presented, there were no issues arising; learners gave very positive feedback on the Covid 19 safety procedures put in place on campus.
- The Executive Director presented an update that included: the new management structure for Glynllifon, Covid 19 safety preparations, cases and procedures and an expression of gratitude to all staff for their work.
- The Director of Agri Food presented a report, which included: an update on the Glynllifon hostel, which was currently unoccupied due to Covid 19; an update on the new animal care building; latest developments with the Glynllifon Rural Hub bid; activity of the knowledge transfer HELIX Project.
- The Executive Director presented information on the North Wales Growth Plan and the Food Technology Centre's successful tender for a £6.2m that included a budget line for strategic projects at Glynllifon.
- The college council advised caution when considering the location for a new build at Glynllifon, in that much of the land was prime agricultural land, which would be a pity to lose.
- The Farm and Forestry Manager presented a report to which members gave their feedback.
- A campus update included information on how 2020's course results had been awarded, there had been no issues with this at Glynllifon. Recruitment figures were displayed, together with details of revised timetabling and staffing.
- Staff matters were reported, there were no issues.

It was noted that a code of conduct was in place to deal with such issues.
- The Principal introduced the new Assistant Principals, who in turn introduced themselves and details of their responsibilities.
- A presentation on General Education provision at Dolgellau was given by the Programme Area Manager and Assistant Principal.
- The Principal's report included: 2020 student results and the difficulties had with awarding bodies over the summer; that the Grŵp Corporation Board had met that day and authorisation given to commence a development plan for the Pwllheli and Dolgellau estates; and the difficulties faced in securing work placements for students in light of Covid 19.
- The Assistant Principal gave a campus update that included: details of the Covid 19 safety measures that had been put in place and recruitment.
- The teaching staff thanked management for the support received throughout the pandemic.
- A discussion was had on digital poverty and the steps taken by the county council and the college to assist those in need, although the cost of accessing broadband at home was also an issue for many and was difficult to remedy.
- Members presented information about local matters, with an issue raised regarding social distancing in the town, involving students. This would receive the Principal's attention.
