

Chair's Foreword

Bu hon yn flwyddyn lwyddiannus, ond heriol, arall i'r Grŵp, gyda'n dysgwyr yn parhau i lwyddo'n well nag erioed, gan ennill gwobrau lu. Mae'r rhain yn dystiolaeth o ddawn ein staff i ddarparu fframwaith y mae ein myfyrwyr yn ffynnu ynddo.

Rhododd y Grŵp gychwyn ar nifer o ddatblygiadau cyfalaf sylweddol. Yr uchafbwynt oedd cwbllhau'r Ganolfan Brifysgol newydd o fri ar safle Llandrillo-yn-Rhos yn ystod yr haf. Yn yr adeilad hwn, ceir cyfleusterau dysgu penigamp i'r rhai sy'n dilyn ein cyrsiau gradd ac ôl-radd, ac mae'n caniatâu i bobl leol gael addysg uwch ar garreg eu drws, heb orfod mynd i'r costau sy'n gysylltiedig â byw oddi cartref. Rydym yn ddiolchgar i Brifysgol Bangor, ac i'n partneriaid prifysgol eraill, am eu cymorth cyson i'r Grŵp yn y cyswllt hwn.

Mae'r Grŵp wedi gwneud cynnydd sylweddol yn CAMDA, ei ganolfan beirianeg ac adeiladu yn Nolgellau, wedi ehangu ac ailwampio ei felin goed yng Nglynllifon, ac wedi ehangu gan symud i adeiladau newydd yn Ninbych. Ymhlieth y prosiectau seilwaith sylweddol, roedd mudo meddalwedd cyfrifiadol er raddfa fawr, ehangu'r ddarpariaeth Wi-Fi ar bob campws, ac adnewyddu cyfleusterau'r ffreutur yn Llandrillo-yn-Rhos.

Er mwyn ymateb i leihad mewn cyllid cyhoeddus yng Nghymru, bu'n rhaid i'r Grŵp weithredu'n gadarnhaol gan fynd i'r afael â dau doriad sylweddol mewn arian rheolaidd. Er gwaethaf y diffyg hwn, mae'r Grŵp wedi llwyddo, gan gynhyrchu gwarged gweithredol o bron i £1m. Mae hyn yn llesol ac yn hanfodol er mwyn ail-fuddsoddi yn ystâd y Grŵp. Ni ddigwyddodd hyn ohoni'hun; yn anorfad, deiliiodd ar leihad yn niferoedd y staff. Ni fydd y caledi hwn yn y sector cyhoeddus yn newid hyd y gellir rhagweld, a nod rhagweithiol y Bwrdd yw mynd i'r afael â hyn drwy annog y sefydliad i fod yn fwy cynaliadwy a gwydn er mwyn iddo allu parhau i ddarparu addysg a chyfleusterau o'r radd flaenaf i'w fyfyrwyr, er gwaethaf y cyfnod ansicr hwn.

This has been another successful, if challenging, year for the Grŵp, with continued improvement in our learners' success rates and numerous accolades. These stand as testament to the creativity of our staff in providing a framework in which our students thrive.

The Grŵp has initiated some significant capital developments, culminating in the summer with the completion of a prestigious new University Centre at the Rhos-on-Sea Campus (the UCCL). This building provides state-of-the-art learning facilities for our undergraduate and postgraduate learners, and allows local people access to Higher Education right on their doorstep, without having to incur the costs of living away. We are grateful to Bangor University for their continued close support to the Grŵp in this regard, and to our other university partners.

The Grŵp has significantly progressed its CAMDA Engineering and Construction hub at Dolgellau, extended and refurbished its sawmill at Glynllifon, and expanded into new premises at Denbigh. Significant infrastructure projects have included a wholesale migration in computing software, extended Wi-Fi provision at all campuses, and refurbished canteen facilities at Rhos-on-Sea.

Response to a downturn in public finance in Wales required the Grŵp to react positively to address two significant cuts in recurrent funding. It has prevailed despite this shortfall, and generated an operational surplus of nearly £1m. This is both healthy and essential for reinvestment into the Grŵp's estate. This achievement does not come in isolation, and has inevitably resulted in a reduction in staffing numbers. Financial austerity in the public sector will not change in the foreseeable future, and it is the Board's proactive aim to address this by promoting a more sustainable and resilient organisation which can continue to provide the best quality learning and facilities for its students, in spite of uncertain times.

Er mwyn symud ymlaen, mae Grŵp Llandrillo Menai wedi gwneud cais am ei gontract Dysgu Seiliedig ar Waith mwyaf erioed, a hydera y bydd ei gontract presennol, sy'n werth £12m, yn cynyddu 25%. Rydym yn parhau i fynd ar drywydd ffrydiau cyllido newydd o Ewrop er mwyn cefnogi prentisiaethau, yr hyfforddiant a'r dysgu yn y tymor canol. Gyda Horizon a Hitachi GE, rydym yn ymwnaeth â phrosiect niwclear Wylfa Newydd, a chredwn fod hyn yn gyfle pwysig i gefnogi a datblygu gweithrediadau arbenigol yn Llangefni. Eleni hefyd, lansiwyd cynllun Ynni Adnewyddadwy arbenigol ac unigryw mewn cydweithrediad â RWE Npower, ac eisoes derbyniodd ugain prentis newydd hyfforddiant ym maes Technolegau Tyrbinau Gwynt.

Bu'n bleser bod yn Gadeirydd a chael hwyluso ymdrechion y Grŵp yn 2013-14. Rywy'n ddiolchgar i aelodau'r Bwrdd am eu cyngor doeth a'u hymrwymiad parhaus i'n myfyrrwr ac i anghenion yr economi leol.

Moving forward, Grŵp Llandrillo Menai has bid for its highest ever Work-based Learning Contract, and it is optimistic of achieving a 25% growth in its current £12m contract. We are continuing to seek new funding streams from Europe to support apprenticeships, training and learning in the mid-term. We are engaged with the Wyfia Newydd Nuclear Project with Horizon and Hitachi GE, and consider this a significant opportunity for specialist operations support and development in Llangefni. This year has also seen a unique specialist Renewables scheme launch in conjunction with RWE Npower, which has already trained twenty new apprentices in Wind Turbine Technologies.

It has been a pleasure to be Chairman and to facilitate the Grŵp's endeavours in 2013-14. I am grateful to the Board for their wise counsel, and sustained commitment to our students and to the needs of the local economy.

Yn 2013-14, gwelodd Grŵp Llandrillo Menai gynnydd boddhaus yn ei ganlyniadau perfformiad allweddol. Cododd cyfradd 'Cwblhau'n Llwyddiannus' y Grŵp i 85% (o 84% yn 2012-13), ac roedd y dystiolaeth a gyflwynodd Estyn yn y ddau arolwg y gwnaethant eu cynnal yn ystod y flwyddyn yn ategu'r chanlyniad cyffredinol hwn.

Cafwyd gwell chanlyniadau Lefel A hefyd ledled y Grŵp, gyda chynnydd sylwedol ac amlwg yn y graddau A-C.

Unwaith eto, cafodd y Grŵp ganlyniadau cadarnhaol iawn yn arolwg Llais y Dysgwr y bydd Llywodraeth Cymru'n ei gynnal yn flynyddol ledled sector Addysg Bellach Cymru. O ran atebion y dysgwyr i gwestiynau am yr addysgu, y dysgu a'r gefnogaeth a gynigir, Grŵp Llandrillo Menai a gafodd y chanlyniadau gorau yng Nghymru. Mae'n braf iawn deall bod y dysgwyr yn fodlon â'n gwasanaethau'n gyffredinol.

Yn ystod y flwyddyn, ailwampiwyd yn sylwedol y cwricwlwm a gynigir gan y Grŵp er mwyn cydymffurfio â gofynion cwricwlwm ôl-16 newydd Cymru.

Cyflwynwyd cyfres lawn o Ragleni Dysgu yn lle'r pecynnau cwricwlaidd blaenorol a gynigid gan y Grŵp. Roedd hwn yn waith mawr, a rhaid i mi fynegi fy niolch a'm hedmygedd o'r tîm o aelodau staff a weithredodd y newid hwn ar adeg pan y bu'n rhaid wynebu toriadau ariannol o tua £1.25 miliwn yn y grant Addysg Bellach.

Yn sgil ad-drefnu'r rheolwyr ledled y Grŵp, rhoddyd strwythur cydlynol a chyson ar waith hefyd ym mhob un o'r colegau, er mwyn cysoni safonau, rhannu arferion da a chydymffurfio mwy â pholisiau a threfnau'r Grŵp. Roedd hyn yn cynnwys newid arweinwyr ym mhob un o golegau'r Grŵp. Llongyfarchiadau a dymuniadau gorau i Dafydd Evans, Ian Rees a Linda Wyn a benodwyd yn Benaethiaid Coleg Llandrillo, Coleg Menai a Choleg Merion-Dwyfor. Mae Kath Coughlin yn parhau yn ei swydd bwysig fel Uwch Gyfarwyddwr y Gwasanaethau Corfforaethol.

Grŵp Llandrillo Menai recorded pleasing improvements in its key performance results in 2013-14. The Grŵp's 'Successful Completion' rate improved to 85% (84% in 2012-13), and supporting this overall outcome was evidence presented by Estyn in two inspections conducted during the year.

A Level results across the Grŵp also improved, with significant improvements in A-C grades particularly evident.

The Learner Voice survey conducted by Welsh Government across the Further Education sector in Wales every year once again revealed very positive results for the Grŵp. The responses by learners to questions about teaching, learning and support offered to them generated the best results in Wales for Grŵp Llandrillo Menai. It is very pleasing to note this overall satisfaction with our services.

The year witnessed a comprehensive overhaul of the Grŵp's curriculum offer to comply with the requirements of a new Post-16 curriculum in Wales. This is characterised by the introduction of a full suite of Programmes of Learning which replaced the previous curriculum package offered by the Grŵp. This was an extensive exercise and I must express my thanks and admiration of the staff team who implemented this change whilst also being subject to financial reductions of around £1.25 million in the Further Education grant.

A management restructure across the Grŵp also implemented a coherent and consistent structure in each of the colleges, geared to securing consistency of standards, sharing of good practice and greater compliance with Grŵp policies and procedures. This included a change in leadership at each of the Grŵp's colleges. Congratulations and best wishes to Dafydd Evans, Ian Rees and Linda Wyn who took up roles as Principal at Coleg Llandrillo, Coleg Menai and Coleg Meirion-Dwyfor. Kath Coughlin continues in her important role as Executive Director of Corporate Services.

Wrth gynllunio'n gyffredinol, byddwn yn rhoi sylw arbennig i firenio a gwella ein cysylltiad â gweithwyr ac i ddarparu gwasanaethau i fusnesau lleol ac er budd economi'r rhanbarth. Yn ystod y flwyddyn, gwaethom adolygu'r gwasanaeth hwn, gan gyfuno timau staff i greu un tîm traws-Grŵp, a byddwn yn lansio gwasanaeth a brand newydd y tîm hwn y flwyddyn nesaf. Yn chwarae rhan amlwg yn hyn o beth, mae'r berthynas â'r ddwy ardal fenter yng Ngogledd Orllewin Cymru, a'r gwaith a wna'r cwmnïau allweddol a'r gadwyn gyflenwi yno.

Mae tri datblygiad yn haeddu cael eu crybwyll yn y cyswllt hwn:

- Llofnodwyd Memorandwm Dealltwriaeth gyda Phŵer Niwclear Horizon yn gynharach yn 2013 er mwyn cynorthwyo i feithrin sgiliau a datblygu rhaglenni hyfforddi ledled Ynys Môn a Gogledd Cymru.
- Cyhoeddodd y Dirprwy Weinidog Sgiliau, Ken Skates, y bwrriad i fuddsoddi £2.3 miliwn mewn hyfforddiant, gan gynnwys prentisiaethau, yn sector ynni Cymru. Bydd y buddsoddiad yn canolbwytio ar baratoi pobl ar gyfer gweithio ar ddatblygiadau mawr ar Ynys Môn, yn enwedig yn yr Wylfa Newydd, yr or saf bŵer niwclear arfaethedig.
- Yn rhan o raglen yr Ynys Ynni, datblygyd ar gampws Llangefni hyfforddiant ym maes peiriannau trwm i'r diwydiant adeiladu, er mwyn darparu cyrsiau hyfforddi arbenigol, na fyddai ar gael fel arall yng Ngogledd Cymru, i weithwyr lleol. Cefnogodd Hitachi Building Machinery y Ganolfan Hyfforddi ym maes Peiriannau Trwm drwy gyflenwi peiriannau tŷrchu newydd o'r radd flaenaf.

Bydd y newidiadau a wnaed yn 2013-14 yn chwarae rhan bwysig o ran sicrhau ein bod yn parhau i lwyddo ac yn ymateb i'r heriau a ddaw i'n rhan yn y dyfodol.

Refining and improving our employee engagement and providing services to local business and the regional economy is a major feature in the Grŵp's overall planning. During the year, we have reviewed this service and merged teams of staff into one cross-Grŵp team whose new brand and service will be launched next year. Particularly prominent in this context is the relationship with the two enterprise zones in North West Wales, and the key companies and supply chain operations based there.

Three developments are worthy of note in this context:

- A Memorandum of Understanding was signed with Horizon Nuclear Power earlier in 2013 to support further skills and training programmes across Anglesey and North Wales.
- Deputy Skills Minister, Ken Skates, announced a £2.3 million investment in training, including apprenticeships, for Wales' energy sector, focussing on preparing people for work on major developments on Anglesey, especially Wylfa Newydd, the planned nuclear power station.
- Construction industry plant training was developed at the Llangefni campus as part of the Energy Island Programme, to provide the local workforce with access to specialist training courses that would not otherwise be available in North Wales. Hitachi Construction Machinery supported the Heavy Plant Training Centre by supplying new state-of-the-art excavators.

The changes implemented in 2013-14 will be significant in ensuring our continued success and in responding to the challenges that we face in the future.

Y Cynnydd a wnaed o ran y Nodau Strategol: Progress towards Strategic Goals:



Sicrhau bod dysgwyr yn cael profiadau rhagorol a chanlyniadau cyson ym mhob un o golegau'r Grŵp.
To achieve excellent learner experience and consistent outcomes in each of the Grŵp's member colleges.

Daeth Dylan Evans (Chweched Y Rhyl) yn ail yn y categori 'Dysgwr y Flwyddyn' yng ngwobrau ColegauCymru ac enillodd deitl 'Myfyriwr y Flwyddyn' yng Ngholeg Llandrillo. Enillodd fedal arian yn Olympiad Ffiseg Prydain (allan o 2,000 o fyfyrwyr ffiseg o bob cwr o'r Deyrnas Unedig) a bellach, wedi iddo gael dwy radd A* mewn Ffiseg a Mathemateg Lefel A (gan gynnwys marciau llawn mewn dau fodiwl Mathemateg) a gradd A mewn Cemeg, mae'n astudio Ffiseg Ddamcaniaethol ym Mhrifysgol Manceinion.

Wedi iddi gael 4 gradd A mewn Mathemateg, Cemeg, Biologia Bagloriaeth Cymru, mae Ffion Trythall (Campws Pwllheli) yn astudio Meddygaeth ym Mhrifysgol Caerdydd. Ymhilith y rhai a wnaeth yn dda ar Gampws Bangor, roedd Edward Meek sydd bellach yn astudio Peirianeg Awyrofod ym Mhrifysgol Manceinion, Rhiannon Berkeley sy'n dilyn cwrs mewn Niwrowyddoniaeth ym Mhrifysgol Caerdydd, a Ben Griffiths a dderbyniodd le i astudio Sŵoleg ym Mhrifysgol Bangor.

Dylan Evans (Rhyl Sixth) was named runner-up in the 'Learner of the Year' category at the ColegauCymru/Colleges Wales awards and 'Student of the Year' at Coleg Llandrillo. He won a silver medal at the British Physics Olympiad (out of 2,000 physics students throughout the UK) and is now studying Theoretical Physics at Manchester University after achieving 2A*s in Physics and Maths A Levels (with full marks in two of his Maths modules) and A grade in Chemistry.

Ffion Trythall (Pwllheli Campus) is studying Medicine at Cardiff University after achieving 4As in Maths, Chemistry, Biology and the Welsh Baccalaureate. Bangor Campus successes included Edward Meek who is studying Aerospace Engineering at Manchester University, Rhiannon Berkeley who is at Cardiff University studying Neuroscience and Ben Griffiths who accepted a place at Bangor University to study Zoology.

Cynigia colegau Grŵp Llandrillo Menai 'Docyn laith' i annog myfyrrwr i gyflwyno pedwar darn o'u gwaith cwrs yn y Gymraeg neu'n ddwyieithog, gan ddyfarnu gwobr o £100 y tymor ym mhob coleg. Ymhilith enillwr y llynedd, roedd Enlli Lloyd Pugh, myfyrrraig ar y cwrs Pâtisserie a Dantéithion Melys yng Ngholeg Llandrillo, Sarah-Jane Wilkinson, myfyrrraig ar y cwrs Antur Awyr Agored yng Ngholeg Meirion-Dwyfor, ac Anna Williams, sy'n dilyn cwrs Teithio a Thristiaeth yng Ngholeg Menai.

Grŵp Llandrillo Menai colleges offer the 'Docyn laith' to encourage students to present four pieces of work in Welsh or bilingually as part of their coursework, with a £100 prize available each term at each College. Last year's winners included Enlli Lloyd Pugh, a Patisserie & Confectionery student at Coleg Llandrillo, Outdoor Adventure student Sarah-Jane Wilkinson from Coleg Meirion-Dwyfor and Anna Williams, a Travel & Tourism student at Coleg Menai.

Mae'n bleser gan y Grŵp adrodd ei fod wedi gwneud cynnydd sylweddol o ran cyrraedd ei nodau strategol, fel y dengys yr enghreifftiau hyn.

The Grŵp is pleased to report that significant progress towards its strategic goals has been achieved, as these examples demonstrate.

3 Buddsoddi yn ein staff ar bob lefel a'u galluogi i ddarparu gwasanaeth rhagorol.

Yn ystod y flwyddyn, cymeradwywyd 8,429 cais i fynd i ddigwyddiadau datblygu staff; roedd 677 o'r rhain yn ddigwyddiadau allanol. Roedd naw aelod staff yn gweithio at radd Meistr, ac un y gweithio at ei Ddoethuriaeth.

To invest in and enable our staff at all levels to provide an excellent service.

During the year, a total of 8,429 applications to attend internal and external staff development events were approved and completed; 677 of these were external events. Nine members of staff were working towards their Masters degrees, and one towards his PhD.

4 Sicrhau bod gan ein dysgwyr y sgiliau hanfodol i'w harfogi ar gyfer dinasyddiaeth a bywyd gwaith cynhyrchiol.

Yn 'Seremoni Sgiliau Hanfodol yn y Gweithle 2014' a gynhaliwyd ym Mangor dan nawdd Llywodraeth Cymru, dathlywyd i gannoedd o ddysgwyr Sgiliau Hanfodol o Goleg Llandrillo, Coleg Menai a WEA Cymru ennill dros 650 o gymwysterau. Traddododd Steve Lyle (Coleg Llandrillo) araih ysbrydoledig fel 'Llais y Dysgwyr'. Soniodd am ei ddyslecsia, gan gynnwys ei brofiadau negyddol yn yr ysgol, a sut y gwaeth y rhaglen newid ei fywyd.

To ensure that our learners have the essential skills to equip them for citizenship and a productive working life.

At the Welsh Government-backed 'Essential Skills in the Workplace Awards 2014' in Bangor, the achievement of over 650 qualifications by hundreds of Essential Skills learners from Coleg Llandrillo, Coleg Menai and WEA Cymru was celebrated. Steve Lyle (Coleg Llandrillo) gave an inspirational speech as the 'Learner Voice', talking about his dyslexia, including negative experiences at school, and how the programme had been life-changing.

5 Datblygu cwricwlwm Addysg Bellach ac Addysg Uwch sy'nadlewyrchu blaenoriaethau lleol a dyheadau a blaenoriaethau economaidd Cymru.

Ymhlieth y datblygiadau cwricwlaidd, roedd dau gwrs a luniwyd ar y cyd â'r Academi Sgiliau Genedlaethol ym maes Pŵer (NSAP). Ar Gampws Llandrillo-yn-Rhos, cwbllaodd y crïw cyntaf o Brentisiaid Tyrbinau Gwynt ddwy flynedd o hyfforddiant yn y coleg, a mynd ymlaen i'w blwyddyn derfynol yn gweithio yn y diwydiant, gan gynnwys prosiect fferm wynt RWE Innogy UK, sef Gwynt y Môr. Cylluniwyd y rhaglen Brentisiaeth ar y cyd gan Grŵp Llandrillo Menai, EU Skills a NSAP, yng nghyd â RWE Innogy UK ac ISO Fab Cyf, ac fe'i hariannwyd yn rhannol gan Gronfa Gymdeithasol Ewrop drwy Lywodraeth Cymru.

Yn dilyn rhaglen beilot a gynhaliwyd yn 2012/13, yn 2013/14 aiddatblygwyd cynnwys y cwrs Gradd Sylfaen mewn Peirianneg Niwclear mewn cydweithrediad â NSAP, ac fe'i dilyswyd a'i gymeradwyo gan Brifysgol Canol Sir Gaerhirfryn, Preston (UCLan). Datblygwyd tair ffrwd wahanol (Cynhyrchu Pŵer, Datgomisiynu a Rheoli Prosiectau Niwclear) er mwyn adlewyrchu'r diwydiant pŵer niwclear yng Ngogledd Cymru.



To develop a Further Education and Higher Education curriculum which reflect local priorities and the economic aspirations and priorities of Wales.

Curriculum developments included two courses devised with the National Skills Academy for Power (NSAP). At the Rhos-on-Sea campus, the first intake of Wind Turbine Apprentices completed two years of college-based training and progressed to their final year where they are working in industry, including at RWE Innogy UK's Gwynt y Môr offshore wind farm project. The Apprenticeship programme was designed by Grŵp Llandrillo Menai, EU Skills and the NSAP, together with RWE Innogy UK and ISO Fab Ltd, and was part-funded by the European Social Fund through the Welsh Government.

Following a pilot in 2012/13, the course content for the Foundation Degree in Nuclear Engineering was redeveloped with the NSAP during 2013/14, and validated and approved by the University of Central Lancashire, Preston (UCLan). Three different streams (Power Generation, Decommissioning and Nuclear Project Management) were developed to reflect the nuclear power industry in North Wales.

Yn rhan o raglen y Bartneriaeth Trosglwyddo Gwybodaeth (KTP), cydweithiodd y Ganolfan Arloesi yng Ngholeg Menai â GL Jones Playgrounds Ltd, Bethesda, i wella a chyflwyno systemau dylunio newydd symlach i ddatblygu offer arloesol ar gyfer llefydd chwarae. Enillodd y bartneriaeth y wobr gyntaf yng Nghystadleuaeth Partneriaeth Orau KTP Cymru am 2013, ac yng Ngwobrau 'Best of the Best' KTP UK a gynhalwyd yn Llundain, derbyniodd 'Gymeradwyaeth Arbennig' gan y beirniaid - y cyntaf erioed i dderbyn gwobr o'r fath.

To support the economic development of North Wales through a comprehensive and integrated employer engagement and business development service.

As part of the Knowledge Transfer Partnership (KTP) programme, Coleg Menai's Innovation Centre worked with GL Jones Playgrounds Ltd of Bethesda to improve and introduce new streamlined design systems to develop innovative playground equipment. The partnership won first prize in the 'Wales KTP Best Partnership Award' for 2013, and at the 'UK Best of the Best KTP Awards' in London, it received an unprecedented 'Special Commendation' from the judges.



7 Denu cymaint â phosibl o gyllid ac incwm gan Lywodraeth Cymru, ffynonellau Ewropeaidd, mentrau, recriwtio myfyrwyr o dramor, gweithgareddau masnachol a chaffael yn effeithlon.

Cafodd prosiect Dyfodol, sy'n ariannu hyfforddiant i fusnesau drwy Gronfa Gymdeithasol Ewrop (ESF), ei ymestyn am ddwy flynedd arall o 2013 tan fis Gorffennaf 2015, gan gynhyrchu £1.2 miliwn o arian ESF ychwanegol. Mae'r prosiect, a arweinir gan Grŵp Llandrillo Menai, mewn partneriaeth â Choleg Cambria a WEA Cymru, yn cynnig hyfforddiant a datblygiad i gwmniau yn y sector preifat yn siroedd Ynys Môn, Conwy, Dinbych a Gwynedd am un tâl o £50 y gweithiwr. Gall diffyg cyllid fod yn rhwystr mawr i ficrofusnesau (cwmniau sydd â llai na 5 aelod staff) gael hyfforddiant. Mae hyn, yn ei dro, yn atal economi Gogledd Cymru rhag tyfu. Hyd yn hyn, mae dros 6,800 o weithwyr o 1,600 cwmni wedi derbyn hyfforddiant.

To maximise funding and income generation from Welsh Government, European sources, enterprise, international recruitment, commercial activities and efficient procurement.

The Dyfodol project, which funds business training through the European Social Fund (ESF), was extended for an extra two years from 2013 until July 2015, generating an additional £1.2 million ESF Funding. Led by Grŵp Llandrillo Menai, in partnership with Coleg Cambria and WEA Cymru, the project offers training and development for private sector companies in Anglesey, Conwy, Denbighshire and Gwynedd for a one-off participation fee of £50 per employee. For micro businesses (companies with fewer than 5 members of staff), finances can be a major barrier to accessing training, which in turn hinders the growth of the North Wales economy. To date, over 6,800 employees from 1,600 companies have participated in training.

Fis Mehefin 2014, yn dilyn 10 mis o waith adeiladu, cwblhawyd Canolfan Brifysgol newydd, werth £4.5 miliwn, yng Ngholeg Llandrillo. Codwyd y Ganolfan Brifysgol mewn partneriaeth â Phrifysgol Bangor, ac mae wedi ennill gradd 'rhagoriaeth' BREEAM am y dull cynaliadwy y cafodd ei dylunio a'i hadeiladu ac y caiff ei rhedeg. Darpara gyfleusterau

o'r radd flaenaf, gan atgyfnerthu rôl Grŵp Llandrillo Menai fel un o brif ddarparwyr cyrsiau prifysgol yng Ngogledd Cymru. Yn yr adeilad pwrspasol, ceir yr offer TG a'r offer amlgyfrwng diweddaraf, ynghyd â chyfleusterau dysgu ac addysgu penigamp, gan gynnwys theatrau darlithio, ystafelloedd seminar, adnoddau llyfrgell a manau astudio o'r radd flaenaf, i fyfyrwyr gradd y Grŵp.

To maintain and develop sustainable and inspiring learning environments with a high technology specification.

A new £4.5 million University Centre at Coleg Llandrillo (UCCL) was completed in June 2014, following 10 months of building works. The UCCL was built in partnership with Bangor University and has been awarded a 'BREEAM: Excellent' rating for its sustainable building design, construction and operation. It provides outstanding facilities and consolidates Grŵp Llandrillo Menai's role as a key provider of university courses in North Wales. The bespoke building is equipped with the latest IT and multimedia equipment, and includes state-of-the-art lecture theatres, seminar rooms, library resources and study areas to provide outstanding teaching and learning facilities for the Grŵp's degree students.

Ysgogi cydweithio a thrawsnewid, a bod yn ganolbwyt o ran gweithio mewn partneriaeth ym maes addysg a hyfforddiant Ôl-14.

Gweithiodd y tri choleg sy'n rhan o'r Grŵp mewn partneriaeth ag ysgolion ac Awdurdodau Lleol i wella profiadau addysgol disgylion ysgol 14-19 oed. Yn 2013/14, elwodd cyfanswm o 2,112 disgylbl (1,651 disgylbl 14-16 oed a 461 disgylbl 16-19 oed) ar yr addysg alwedigaethol a ddarperir gan dri choleg y Grŵp. Roedd y ddarpariaeth hon yn cynnwys profiadau galwedigaethol mewn meysydd fel Peirianneg, Adeiladu, Cyfryngau, TGCh, Arlwo ac Amaethyddiaeth.

Er i'r Grŵp ganolbwytio'n bennaf ar brofiadau'r dysgwyr, chwaraeodd ran allweddol hefyd yn y trefniadau o ran sbarduno, cynllunio a chydlynur'r cyrsiau hyn. Enghraift o hyn oedd rôl ganolog y Grŵp yng ngwaith Consortiwmm Addysg Ôl-16 Gwynedd ac Ynys Môn, a ddenodd gyllid o Ewrop i sefydlu a datblygu ffordd fwy systematig o sicrhau bod dysgwyr 16-19 oed yn cael yr addysg fwyaf perthnasol, o'r ansawdd gorau a mwyaf cost effeithiol.

To be a driving force for collaboration and transformation and a hub for partnership working in post-14 education and training.

The three colleges within the Grŵp worked in partnership with schools and Local Authorities to enhance the educational experiences of 14-19 pupils in schools. In 2013/14, a total of 2,112 pupils (1,651 in the 14-16 age range and 461 in the 16-19 age range) benefited from vocational education provided by the Grŵp's three colleges. This provision included vocational experiences in areas such as Engineering, Construction, Media, ICT, Catering and Agriculture.

While the main focus was on the experiences the learners received, the Grŵp was also a key player in the emerging arrangements for driving, planning and co-ordinating these courses. An example was the Grŵp's central role in the work of the Gwynedd and Ynys Môn Post-16 Education Consortium, which attracted European funding to establish and develop a more systematic way of ensuring that 16-19 learners are provided with the most relevant, highest quality and most cost-effective education.

Lansiwyd prosiect deuddeg mis, Llwybrau Blaengar i Feithrin Cysylltiadau (PEP), a arweinir gan Grŵp Llandrillo Menai mewn cydweithrediad â Gyfra Cymru a'r Adran Waith a Phensiynau. Bwriad y prosiect oedd gwella'r cyfleoedd i bobl ifanc 19-24 oed sydd wedi ymddieithrio ledled siroedd Conwy a Dinbych.

Comisiynwyd y prosiect gan Fwrdd Gwasanaethau Lleol Siroedd Conwy a Dinbych mewn ymateb i ystadegau a ddangosai nad oedd llawer o rai 19-24 oed yng Nghymru mewn addysg, mewn cyflogaeth nac mewn hyfforddiant (NEET) a bod llawer iawn o rai 17-24 oed yn hawlio Lwfans Ceiswyr Gwaith. Cefnogwyd y prosiect gan Gronfa Gymdeithasol Ewrop drwy Lywodraeth Cymru.

Mewn digwyddiadau a gynhalwyd ledled siroedd Conwy a Dinbych, ymgynghorwyd â thros 200 o bobl ifanc a 60 aelod staff, gan gasglu gwybodaeth ddefnyddiol sy'n hanfodol er mwyn cynnal y ddarpariaeth a siapio'r gwasanaeth ar gyfer y dyfodol. Eisoes deilliodd hyn ar newidiadau yn y modd y cyflenwir y gwasanaeth.

To support regeneration in North Wales' communities through a comprehensive programme of Adult & Community-based employability and skills activities.

A twelve month Progressive Engagement Pathways (PEP) project led by Grŵp Llandrillo Menai, working with Careers Wales and the Department of Work & Pensions, was launched, aimed at improving the opportunities for disengaged young people aged 19-24 years across Conwy and Denbighshire.

The project was commissioned by the Conwy & Denbighshire Local Service Board in response to statistics showing high levels of 19-24 year olds in Wales not in education, employment or training (NEET) and 17-24 year olds claiming Job Seekers' Allowance. The project was supported by the European Social Fund, through the Welsh Government.

At consultation events across Conwy and Denbighshire involving over 200 young people and 60 staff, valuable information and insights were gathered which are proving fundamental in supporting and shaping how service provision will be delivered in the future and which have already resulted in changes being made to service delivery.

Yn sgil yr archwiliad a gynhaliwyd ar ei gampysau, daliodd Coleg Llandrillo afael ar ei ddyfarniad Lefel Pump, a chododd Coleg Menai a Choleg Meirion-Dwyfor i Lefel Pump o'r Lefel Pedwar a ddyfarnwyd iddynt yn flaenorol. Mae'r Ddraig Werdd yn cydnabod rheoli amgylcheddol effeithiol, gan wobrwo camau a gymerir i wella'r amgylchedd.

To ensure a healthy, safe and equitable working environment, which reflects the diversity of our staff and learners.

Grŵp Llandrillo Menai achieved the highest level possible for its environmental standards and green agenda, after being awarded Groundwork Wales' Green Dragon Environmental Management Level 5 accreditation across all three colleges. During an audit of its campuses, Coleg Llandrillo retained its Level Five award, whilst Coleg Menai and Coleg Meirion-Dwyfor moved up from the Level Four standard previously achieved. Green Dragon recognises effective environmental management and rewards actions taken to achieve environmental improvements.

Defnyddiwyd hanesion myfyrwyr llwyddiannus fel Owain Jones i hyrwyddo'r colegau mewn amrywiaeth o gyfryngau. Yn wreiddiol, cofrestrodd Owain ar gwrs Gwaith Saer Lefel 1 yng Ngholeg Meirion-Dwyfor, pan oedd yn aros i ymuno â'r fyddin. Ond mwynhaodd y cwrs gymaint, daliodd ati i astudio yn y coleg, gan gwblhau Lefel 3 mewn Gwaith Saer ar Safle Adeiladu ac ennill medalau aur mewn cystadlaethau Adeiladu Sgiliau, yn lleol ac yn genedlaethol, yn ogystal â sefydlu ei fusnes ei hun.

Bydd yn ymarfer bob mis gyda chymorth rheolwr hyfforddi cymwys. Fis Mai 2015, bydd yn cystadlu am le yn y tîm a fydd yn cynrychioli'r Deyrnas Unedig ym Mrasil.

To ensure a high profile and positive public relations and marketing profile, which underpins recruitment targets and enhances the Grŵp's reputation in the communities it serves.

Biographies of successful students like Owain Jones were used to promote the colleges in a variety of media. Owain initially enrolled at Coleg Meirion-Dwyfor on a Level 1 Carpentry course to fill in time before joining the army, but enjoyed his course so much that he continued his studies at college, completing Level 3 Site Carpentry and winning gold at regional and Wales SkillBuild competitions, as well as setting up his own business.

After winning gold at the SkillBuild UK National Finals in July 2014, he was named in Squad UK for WorldSkills São Paulo 2015 and will train each month with the support of a dedicated training manager. In May 2015, he will compete for a place in the team that will represent the UK in Brazil.



In the Biology and Chemistry Olympiads, 16 A Level and International Baccalaureate students from Coleg Llandrillo won awards. Six won bronze medals and ten received commendations.

Skills Wales Competitions

Students from the three colleges won numerous awards in regional heats, with many achieving success in the Skills Wales finals.

In the Welsh finals, medal successes included gold, silver and bronze in both 3D Modelling & Animation and Mechanical Engineering (CAD).

There were also gold medals in Professional Cookery, Construction and Painting & Decorating, silver and bronze medals in Accounting and in Web Design, and bronze medals in Vehicle Body Repair and Automotive Engineering.

Hairdressing & Beauty Therapy and Health & Care students also picked up medals in regional heats in England.

Eight students qualified for the UK WorldSkills competitions in Birmingham in November 2014.

Arolygiadau Estyn

Cynhaliodd Estyn ddau arolygiad yn ystod y flwyddyn, ac roedd y canlyniadau'n fodhaol iawn.

Fis Tachwedd 2013, arolygwyd darpariaeth y Grŵp o ran Dysgu yn y Gwaith, ac aseswyd bod ein perfformiad cyfredol yn 'Dda', a'n rhagolygon o ran gwella'n 'Rhagorol'. Ymhilth sylwadau Estyn, cafwyd y datganiadau cryno a ganlyn:

"At ei gilydd, mae'r cyfraddau y mae dysgwyr yn cyflawni eu fframweithiau cymhwyster llawn arnynt yn dda. Dengys data nas gwiriyd bod cyfraddau cyrhaeddiad yn parhau i wella ar draws bron pob maes rhaglen. Mae dysgwyr yn mwynhau eu dysgu ac yn teimlo'n ddiogel yn eu hamgylcheddau hyfforddi.

Mae ansawdd yr addysgu, yr hyfforddi a'r asesu yn dda ar y cyfan, ac fe geir ambell engraifft o arfer ragorol. At ei gilydd, mae ansawdd y gofal, cymorth ac arweiniad yn dda a chaff dysgwyr eu cynorthwyo'n dda i'w helpu i ddatblygu eu haddysg a'u medrau cyflogadwyedd.

Gall dysgwyr fanteisio ar ystod eang iawn o raglenni hyfforddi ac adnoddau a chyfleusterau da i ragorol ar gyfer hyfforddiant yn y gwaith ac i ffwrdd o'r gwaith."

Fis Mehefin 2014, cynhaliodd Estyn Adolygiad Blynnyddol o Berfformiad cyffredinol y Grŵp ym maes Addysg Bellach. Ni phennir graddau mewn Adolygiadau Perfformiad Blynnyddol, ond roedd y datganiadau a ganlyn yn disgrifio'n perfformiad yn gyffredinol:

"Mae Grŵp Llandrillo Menai wedi gwella cyfraddau llwyddo, ar y cyfan, ar draws pob cwrs o un pwynt canran dros y ddwy flynedd diwethaf. Mae bron pob dysgwr yn cwblhau eu cyrsiau ac mae'r Grŵp yn y chwarter uchaf o'r holl golegau yng Nghymru. Mae gan y Grŵp ffocws cryf ar safonau a pherfformiad. Mae hyn yn sbarduno gwelliannau ar lefel meysydd cwricwlwm ac ar draws campysau."



Estyn Inspections

Two inspections by Estyn took place during the year, with pleasing results.

In November 2013, the Grŵp's Work-based Learning provision was inspected, and our current performance assessed as 'Good', with the prospects for improvement assessed as 'Excellent'. Estyn's commentary included the following summary statements:

"Overall, the rates at which learners attain their full qualification frameworks are good. Unverified data shows that attainment rates are continuing to improve across almost all programme areas. Learners enjoy their learning and feel safe in their training environments.

The quality of teaching, training and assessment is good overall with a few examples of excellent practice. Overall, the quality of care support and guidance is good and learners are supported well to help them develop their education and employability skills.

Learners have access to a very wide range of training programmes and good to excellent training resources and facilities for both on and off-the-job training."

An Annual Performance Review (APR) conducted by Estyn in June 2014 considered the Grŵp's overall Further Education performance. APRs are not graded but the following statements highlighted our overall performance:

"Grŵp Llandrillo Menai has improved overall success rates across all courses by one percentage point over the last two years. Nearly all learners successfully complete their courses and the Grŵp is in the top quarter of all colleges in Wales. The Grŵp has a strong focus on standards and performance. This drives improvements at curriculum area level and across campuses."

Lefel A

Roedd canlyniadau Lefel A Grŵp Llandrillo Menai'n sylweddol uwch na'r cymaryddion cenedlaethol yng Nghymru ac yn y Deyrnas Unedig.

Yn 2013/14, cynyddodd cyfradd lwyddo'r Grŵp yn yr arholiadau Lefel A i 98% (Cymaryddion Cenedlaethol: Y Deyrnas Unedig 98%, Cymru 97.5%). Roedd hyn yn cymharu â chyfradd lwyddo o 97.4% (Cymarebau Cenedlaethol: Y Deyrnas Unedig 98.1%, Cymru 97.6%) yn 2012/13.

Cododd y nifer o raddau A*-C a gafwyd o 70.9% i 77.1%, gan guro cyfartaledd y Deyrnas Unedig, sef 76.7%, a chyfartaledd Cymru, sef 75.2%.

Yng Ngholeg Meirion-Dwyfor, roedd y ganran graddau A*-C, sef 81.5%, yn nodedig iawn.

Ledled y chwe champs, safodd dros 750 o fyfyrwyr arholiadau Lefel A a Lefel AS, gyda phawb yn llwyddo mewn 96 allan o 107 pwnc.

A Levels

Grŵp Llandrillo Menai's A Level results were significantly above both Welsh and UK national comparators.

A Level results for the Grŵp showed an increase in the pass rate to 98% (National Comparators: UK 98%, Wales 97.5%) in 2013/14. This compared with a pass rate of 97.4% (National Comparators: UK 98.1%, Wales 97.6%) in 2012/13.

The number of A*-C grades achieved increased from 71% to 78%, exceeding both the UK average of 76.7% and the Welsh average of 75.2%.

At Coleg Meirion-Dwyfor, the number of A*-C grades achieved was an impressive 81.5%.

Over 750 students sat A Level and AS Level exams, achieving 100% passes in 96 out of 107 subjects, delivered across six campuses.

Canlyniadau Arolwg

Yn Arolwg Llais y Dysgwyr Cymru a gynhaliodd Ipsos Mori yn 2014, cymerodd 66,899 o fyfyrwyr o bob cwr o Gymru ran, gan roi cyfle i ni feincnodi yn erbyn pob coleg arall yn y sector.

Roedd yr arolwg yn cynnwys dysgwyr Addysg Bellach (37,917), rhai sy'n dysgu yn y gweithle, oedolion sy'n dysgu yn y gymuned, a rhai sy'n dilyn cyrsiau Cymraeg i Oedolion. Cymerodd cyfanswm o 3,911 myfyriwr ran o Grŵp Llandrillo Menai.

Dangosodd y canlyniadau fod myfyriwr o dri choleg y Grŵp ymhliith yr hapusaf yn y wlad, gyda'r Grŵp yn sgorio'n sylweddol uwch na'r cyfartaledd ym mhob un o gwestiynau'r arolwg.

O blith y myfyriwr Addysg Bellach, mynegodd 88% eu bod yn fodlon iawn â'u darpariaeth, a nododd nifer sylweddol, sef 93%, o'r rhai sy'n dysgu yn y gweithle fod eu cyrsiau'n 'Dda' neu'n 'Dda lawn'.

Survey Results

In the Learner Voice Wales survey carried out at the beginning of 2014 by Ipsos Mori, 66,899 students across Wales took part, providing an opportunity to benchmark against every other college in the sector.

The survey included learners in Further Education (37,917), Work-based Learning, Adult Community Learning and Welsh for Adults. A total of 3,911 students took part from Grŵp Llandrillo Menai.

The results showed that students from the Grŵp's three colleges, were amongst the happiest in the country, with the Grŵp scoring well above average for every single question in the survey.

Among Further Education students, 88% indicated that they were highly satisfied with their provision, whilst an impressive 93% of Work-based learners rated their courses as 'Good' or 'Very Good'.




