## SUSTAINABILITY AND ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT

Grŵp Llandrillo Menai was formed in April 2012 following the merger between Coleg Llandrillo, Coleg Menai and Coleg Meirion Dwyfor. The Grŵp has sites in Conwy, Denbighshire, Gwynedd and Ynys Môn with provision at a large number of community based venues. The Grŵp provides a wide range of education and training, both full and part-time, at Further and Higher Education levels and has approximately 1,550 staff and delivers activity to around 20,000 learners each year.

The Grŵp Statement is to support the creation of a sustainable Wales by embedding sustainability at the heart of everything we do.

To recycle or reuse materials where possible and to dispose of waste in the most environmentally friendly way.


To ensure that the College has a minimal negative effect on the local environment and makes a positive contribution to the local community and its environment.
