rhagair / foreword

Mae'n bleser gennyf gyflwyno'r adroddiad blynnyddol hwn am y flwyddyn 2015-16.

Fel gweddill y sector cyhoeddus, parhaodd Grŵp Llandrillo i wynebu pwyllau ariannol o ganlyniad i fesurau darbodus Llywodraeth y Deyrnas Unedig, economi leol wledig sy'n gwegian, ac addasiadau negyddol sylwedol i bensiynau. Fodd bynnag, llwyddasom i gynhyrchu dros £1m o gyllid gweithredol a gwelwyd gwelliant pellach yng nghanlyniadau'r myfyrwyr, gyda chyfradd lwyddo'r ddarpariaeth addysg bellach yn codi i 88%. Pleser arbennig yw nodi bod cyfradd lwyddo'r myfyrwyr llawn amser wedi codi 2% a'u bod wedi cael canlyniadau campus yn yr arholiadau Lefel A. Rydym yn ddyledus i dîm ymroddgar a gweithgar o staff addysgu, staff cefnogi a rheolwyr am wneud y llwyddiant hwn yn bosibl, er gwaethaf yr heriau.

Cyflawnodd y myfyrwyr sawl camp nodedig yn ystod y flwyddyn, gan gynnwys dwy o'n hyfforddeion yn cael eu cydnabod yn genedlaethol, gan ennill teitlau Hyfforddeion y Flwyddyn. Disgleiriodd ein staff hefyd, gyda Mark McDonough yn cael ei enwi'n Diwtor y Flwyddyn (Cymru) am ei waith yn datblygu'r cwricwlwm ynni adnewyddadwy.

Parhawn i gydweithio'n agos â diwydiant ac mae ein cysylltiadau allweddol â chwmmiäu fel Horizon, RWE a Babcock yn dal i ffynnu a datblygu. Ond, sylwedolwn fel sefydliad fod ein heonomi leol yn ddibynol ar gwmniäu llai ac rydym wedi'u cefnogi hwythau drwy ddarparu bron i 2000 o brentisiaid yn yr ardal a bu dros 9065 o weithwyr mewn cyrsiau gwella sgiliau.

Dal i ddatblygu mae ein hystâd a'n hisadeiledd, ac yn 2015-16 rhoddyd pwyslais penodol ar ddatblygu ein hisadeiledd TG. Er mwyn ymateb i alwad ein myfyrwyr am Wi-Fi cyflymach ac ehangach, rydym wedi buddsoddi'n sylwedol mewn rhwydwaith sydd, fwy na thebyg, y rhwydwaith Wi-Fi un-pwrrpas mwyaf yng Nghymru.

Mae gwrando ar ein myfyrwyr yn rhan allweddol o'n llwyddiant ac adlewyrchir hyn yn yr adborth rhagorol a gawsom gan y myfyrwyr, yn enwedig ein myfyrwyr AU, yn yr arolwg a gynhalwyd eleni. Yn benodol, gosododd yr Asiantaeth Sicrhau Ansawdd ar gyfer Addysg Uwch y Grŵp ymhlieth Prifysgolion gorau'r Deyrnas Unedig.

Bu'r Grŵp hefyd yn cydweithio'n glos â Bwrdd Uchelgais Economaidd Gogledd Cymru; elfen allweddol oedd datblygu cyfres o brosiectau refeniw Cronfa Gymdeithasol Ewrop i fynd i'r afael ag anghenion y rhanbarth o ran sgiliau ac ag ymddieithrio ymhlieth yr ifanc. Mae'r prosiectau bellach ar waith a byddant yn darparu cymorth ariannol derbyniol er mwyn i'r Grŵp weithio ym maes ymgysylltu â chyflwyniwr ac adfywio cymunedau. Rydym yn gwirioneddol obeithio y bydd cwmniäu lleol yn gweld yn dda i fanteisio ar y cyfleoedd hyn tra bydd cyllid Ewropeaidd o'r fath ar gael.

Yn ystod y flwyddyn, ymddeolodd ein Prif Weithredwr blaenorol, Mr Glynn Jones, ar ôl arwain y Grŵp yn llwyddiannus iawn. Diolchwn iddo am ei arweinyddiaeth a dymunwn yn dda iddo ar ei ymddeoliad. Yn ogystal, wedi blynnyddoedd o roi o'u hamser a'u harbenigedd, ymddeolodd sawl aelod o'r Bwrdd, sef Mrs Mair Jones, Mr Glynn Catley a Mr Chris Jackson. Yn eu tro, bu'r tri yn Gadeiryddion eu priod Fyrddau.

I gloi, rydym yn falch o nodi bod y Grŵp wedi llwyddo i wrthsefyll sawl her ac wedi parhau i ddatblygu ei adnoddau, gan sicrhau bod y myfyrwyr yn cael canlyniadau o'r radd flaenaf. Rydym yn hyderus y bydd y Grŵp yn parhau i gynnig y ddarpariaeth orau bosibl yn y dyfodol ac y bydd, drwy arloesi, yn parhau i wella ansawdd y ddarpariaeth honno.

It is a pleasure to present this annual report for the year 2015-16.

Grŵp Llandrillo Menai, in common with the rest of the public sector, continued to come under financial pressure as a consequence of the UK Government's austerity measures, in addition to the rural local economy, which is struggling, and significant negative pension adjustments. However, we still managed to generate over £1m in operating cash and further improved student outcomes to a success rate of 88% for further education provision. Particularly pleasing was a 2% increase in full-time student success and a strong A Level outcome. These results are due to a committed and hardworking team of teaching and support staff and managers who have enabled this success, despite the challenges.

There were several notable achievements by students during the course of the year, including two of our trainees being recognised at a national level, winning Trainees of the Year. Our staff also shone, with Mark McDonough being recognised as the Welsh Tutor of the Year, for his work in developing the renewables curriculum offer.

We continue to work closely with industry and key relationships with companies such as Horizon, RWE and Babcock continue to flourish and develop. However, we recognise as an organisation that our local economy is driven by smaller companies and we have supported them by providing nearly 2000 apprentices in the area. In addition, over 9065 employees have attended upskilling courses.

Our estate and infrastructure continues to develop, with 2015-16 seeing a particular emphasis on our IT infrastructure. Responding to our students call for a faster and more extensive Wi-Fi capability, we have invested significantly to create probably the largest dedicated Wi-Fi network in Wales.

Listening to our students is a key feature of our success and this is reflected in the excellent student survey feedback we received this year, in particular from our HE students. Notably the Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education placed the Grŵp amongst the top universities in the UK.

The Grŵp has also been working closely with the North Wales Economic Ambition Board (NWEAB); a key driver of which has been the development of a series of European Social Fund (ESF) revenue projects to support the skills needs of the region and to tackle youth disengagement. The projects are now in place and will provide a welcome package of funding support for the Grŵp's work on employer engagement and community regeneration. We sincerely hope that local companies will see fit to maximise on these opportunities while such EU funding is available.

During the year, our previous Chief Executive, Mr Glynn Jones, retired, having taken the Grŵp forward with great success. We thank him for his leadership and wish him well in his retirement. Several Board Members also retired, having given many years of their time and expertise, in particular Mrs Mair Jones, Mr Glynn Catley and Mr Chris Jackson, who, all in their time, served as Chairs of their respective Boards.

In conclusion, we are pleased to note that the Grŵp has withstood many challenges and continued to develop its resources and high quality results for its students. We look forward with confidence that the Grŵp will continue to offer the best and, through innovation, keep on the path of continued quality improvement.

Yn dilyn ei adolygiad fis Mawrth 2016, cadarnhaodd yr Asiantaeth Sicrhau Ansawdd Addysg Uwch (QAA) ansawdd a safonau darpariaeth y Grŵp.

The Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education (QAA) confirmed the quality and standards of provision at the Grŵp, following its review in March 2016.




Yn ôl adolygwyr y QAA, roedd safonau academaidd y Grŵp, ansawdd y cyfleoedd dysgu a roddir i fyfyrwyr, ynghyd ag ansawdd y wybodaeth am y cyfleoedd dysgu hynny, yn bodloni disgwyliadau'r Deyrnas Unedig. Yn ogystal â hynny, roedd Grŵp Llandrillo Menai'n un o bedwar Coleg Addysg Bellach allan o 62 ledled Cymru a Lloegr i dderbyn cymeradwyaeth gan y QAA am wella cyfleoedd dysgu i fyfyrwyr.

Gall y Grŵp yn awr arddangos Nod Ansawdd yr Asiantaeth Sicrhau Ansawdd, sy'n rhoi gwybod i fyfyrwyr y Deyrnas Unedig ac i fyfyrwyr tramor ei fod yn bodloni'r gofynion cenedlaethol o ran safonau ac ansawdd.

QAA reviewers judged that the Grŵp's academic standards, the quality of its student learning opportunities, and the quality of information about its learning opportunities all meet UK expectations. Furthermore, the Grŵp was one of only 4 out of a total of 62 Further Education colleges who achieved a commended judgment for 'the enhancement of student learning opportunities.'

The Grŵp can now display the QAA Quality Mark, indicating to UK and international students that it meets national requirements for standards and quality.

Babcock International Group

Arwyddodd y Grŵp Femorandwm Cyd-ddealltwriaeth gyda Babcock International Group er mwyn sefydlu cyflenwad lleol o brentisiaid talentog ym maes awyrenneg. Bydd y prentisiaid yn derbyn hyfforddiant gyda Babcock yn RAF Y Fali ac yn astudio ar gyfer eu cymhwyster Peirianeg Awyrenegol yn adran Beirianeg Coleg Menai. Caiff 33 o beirianwyr awyrenegol eu hyfforddi mewn ymateb i bwysigrwydd cynyddol yr ysgol hyfforddi peilotiaid yn RAF Y Fali.

The Grŵp signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Babcock International Group to build a local pool of talented aeronautical apprentices. The apprentices will train with Babcock at RAF Valley and study their Aeronautical Engineering qualification in Coleg Menai's Engineering department. 33 aeronautical engineers will be trained in response to the growing importance of the pilot training school at RAF Valley.

Ynys Ynni / Energy Island

Mae'r Grŵp yw cydweithio'n agos â Phŵer Niwclear Horizon, Menter Newydd a phartneriaid eraill. Ei nod yw rhoi i'r bobl leol y sgiliau sy'n angenrheidiol i gael gwaith yn y Wylfa Newydd (neu yn y gadwyn gyflenwi) a chael gyrfaoedd llwyddiannus yng Ngogledd Orllewin Cymru. Yn ystod 2015/16, cwblhaodd y Grŵp brosiect llwyddiannus iawn (a ariannwyd gan Lywodraeth Cymru) a roddodd brofiadau cyffrous i 2,500 o ddisgyblion ysgol ym maes gwyddoniaeth, technoleg, peirianneg a mathemateg (STEM).

The Grŵp is working closely with Horizon Nuclear Power, Menter Newydd and other partners, with the aim of providing local people with the skills to gain work as part of the Wylfa Newydd development (or in the supply chain) and cultivate successful careers in North West Wales. During 2015/2016, the Grŵp completed a very successful project (funded by Welsh Government) which provided 2,500 school pupils with exciting STEM experiences.

Prentisiaethau Uwch Higher Apprenticeships

Mae'r Grŵp wedi cynyddu ei ddarpariaeth Prentisiaethau Uwch mewn modd strategol drwy ddatblygu dros 13 llwybr gwahanol. Hyd yma, cofrestrodd dros 400 dysgwr profiadol, a oedd yn ysgwyddo cyfrifoldebau rheoli ac a allai ddilyn rhaglen academaidd a galwedigaethol ar lefel 4 neu lefel 5, gyda ni. Mae nifer sylweddol yn dal i ddilyn y rhaglen a rhagwelwn y bydd y cyfraddau llwyddo'n dda.

The Grŵp has strategically grown its Higher Apprenticeship provision by developing over 13 different pathways. To date we have enrolled over 400 experienced learners who are all in management roles and able to undertake academic and vocational study at level 4 or 5. A significant number of enrolments are still on scheme and we predict good achievement rates.

Gwobrau Prentisiaethau Cymru Apprenticeship Awards Cymru

Bu'r seremoni wobrwyd genedlaethol yn noson llwyddiannus i Grŵp Llandrillo Menai, gyda'r asesydd, Mark McDonough, a'r ddwy ddysgwraig, Cassidy Jones ac Angharad Jones, yn derbyn gwobrau. Enillodd Mark deitl Asesydd Dysgu Seiliedig ar Waith y Flwyddyn, derbyniodd Cassidy wobr Dysgwr y Flwyddyn - Hyffordeiaeth (Ymgysylltu) a chyflwynwyd gwobr Dysgwr y Flwyddyn - Hyffordeiaeth (Lefel 1) i Angharad.

The national awards ceremony proved a successful evening for Grŵp Llandrillo Menai as assessor Mark McDonough and two learners, Cassidy Jones and Angharad Jones, all collected awards. Mark won the Work-based Learning Assessor of the Year award, Cassidy collected the Traineeship Learner of the Year (Engagement) Award and Angharad won the Traineeship Learner of the Year (Level 1) Award.

Prosiect SEE ac Academi Busnes Gogledd Cymru SEE Project & North Wales Business Academy (NWBA)

Yn ystod y flwyddyn, cymeradwywyd dau brosiect mawr sy'n canolbwyntio ar gyflogwyr ac ariennir gan Gronfa Gymdeithasol Ewrop. Mae'r prosiect Sgiliau ar gyfer Cyflogwyr a Gweithwyr (SEE) yn darparu rhaglenni hyfforddi a chymorthdal i fusnesau ledled Gogledd Cymru er mwyn gwella sgiliau a gwybodaeth gweithwyr. Eisoes darparwyd hyfforddiant galwedigaethol ar ffurf cymwysterau NVQ a chyrsiau byr mewn amrediad o sectorau allweddol.

Mewn partneriaeth â darparwyr AB/AU ledled y rhanbarth, cefnoga Academi Busnes Gogledd Cymru fusnesau yn y sector preifat drwy ddarparu iddynt raglenni strategol a phwrpasol ym maes rheoli. Cynllunir y rhaglenni hyn i gyd-fynd â thargedau penodol y sefydliadau.

During the course of the year, two major employer-focused European Social Fund (ESF) projects were approved. The Skills for Employers and Employees (SEE) project provides businesses across North Wales with subsidised training and development to raise employee skills and knowledge. Vocational training in the form of NVQs and short courses has already been provided in a range of key sectors.

In partnership with HE/FE providers across the region, the innovative North Wales Business Academy (NWBA) supports private sector businesses with a strategic and tailored management programme, designed to meet specific organisational goals.



Rhyngwladol International

O ran y gwaith rhyngwladol a wneir mewn colegau, mae'r pwyslais yn newid i gefnogi datblygu addysg a hyfforddiant galwedigaethol. Rydym wedi llwyddo i ymateb i hyn drwy gyfrwng cyfres o gynnlluniau sy'n seiliedig ar brosiectau, gan ddatblygu a rhoi cwriclwm Mentergarwch newydd ar waith ar ran sector galwedigaethol Gwlad Thai; datblygu sgiliau arwain mewn colegau galwedigaethol yng Ngwlad Thai a chyflwyno cyrsiau datblygu staff yn y gweithle yn Ningbo, Tsieina. Yn rhan o'r berthynas gynaliadwy hon a gweithgareddau'r prosiect, croesawodd y Grŵp dros gant o ymwelwyr, yn weithwyr ac yn fyfyrwyr, i Ogledd Cymru.

International work in colleges is experiencing a shift in emphasis towards supporting the development of vocational educational and training. We have been successful in responding to this with a range of project-based initiatives, including the development and implementation of a new Enterprise curriculum for the Thai vocational sector; leadership development in Thai vocational colleges, and delivering work-based learning staff development in Ningbo, China. As part of this sustainable relationship development and project activities, the Grŵp has welcomed over 100 professional and study visitors to North Wales.

Prifysgol Bangor Bangor University

Ystyrid ein perthynas â Phrifysgol Bangor yn batrwm o ran cydweithio ym maes AU/AB. Sefydlwyd partneriaeth i gynnwys ym holl gydweithio a wnaeon â Bangor, sy'n cynnwys darparu cyrsiau AU ledled y Grŵp, marchnata'n rhyngwladol ar y cyd, y ddarpariaeth Cymraeg i Oedolion, cyd-brosiectau Ewropeaidd a chyrsiau ym y Ganolfan Rheolaeth ym Mangor.

Trosolwg o'r Partneriaethau 14-19 ag Ysgolion 14-19 School Partnerships Overview

Mae Grŵp Llandrillo Menai'n cydweithio'n agos a awdurdodau lleol siroedd Conwy, Dinbych, Gwynedd a Môn i ddarparu addysg a hyfforddiant yn ei golegau i ddisgyblion ysgol 14-19 oed. Yn 2016/17, astudiodd y dysgwyr oddeutu 1500 o bynciau galwedigaethol Lefel 2 a 3 a chymwysterau Lefel A mewn ystod eang o bynciau.

Dyma rai o'r pethau a gyflawnwyd yn 2016:

- Darparwyd hyfforddiant i 36 o ddysgwyr Peirianeg, a fydd yn eu helpu i feithrin y sgiliau sy'n angenrheidiol i fanteisio ar ddatblygiadau'r Ynys Ynni.
- Llwyddodd pawb mewn 46 pwnc, gan gynnwys cyrsiau Adeiladu, Peirianeg, Busnes, Trin Gwallt, Celfyddydau Perfformio a TG.
- Ar ôl cwblhau cyrsiau 14-16, aeth nifer dda ymlaen i ddilyn rhaglenni AB llawn amser ledled y Grŵp

Grŵp Llandrillo Menai works closely with Conwy, Denbighshire, Gwynedd and Mon local authorities to deliver education and training in college as part of a learner's 14-19 school education. In 2016/17, learners undertook approximately 1500 subjects at Vocational Levels 2, 3 and A Level in a wide range of subjects.

Achievements in 2016 included:

- Delivery of training to 36 Engineering learners, to develop the skills needed to take advantage of the developments on Energy Island.
- 100% success in 46 subjects, including Construction, Engineering, Business, Hairdressing, Performing Arts and IT.
- Very good rates of progression from 14-16 into full-time FE programmes across the Grŵp

Our relationship with Bangor University is seen as a model of HE/FE collaboration. A new partnership structure has been put into place to encompass all of our work with Bangor, which includes delivery of HE courses across the Grŵp, joint International marketing, Welsh for Adults provision, joint European projects and courses within the Bangor Management Centre.

Canolfan Cefni

Yn ystod yr haf, cwblhawyd adeilad modwlar deulawr newydd, a gosiodd £2.6m i'w godi, ar gyfer myfyrwyr yr Adran Sgiliau Byw'n Annibynnol a Hyfforddeion. Mae'r adeilad pwrpasol hwn yn cynnwys cegin hyfforddi i ddysgu sgiliau sylfaenol, cegin fasnachol a salon gwaltl, yn ogystal ag ystafelloedd dosbarth a chyfleusterau TG o'r radd flaenaf. Mae gan yr adeilad sgôr A o ran effeithlonrwydd ynni ac mae'n caniatáu i'r Grŵp resymoli ei ystâd a lleihau costau cynnal a chadw.

A new £2.6m two storey modular building for Independent Living Skills and Traineeship learners was completed over the summer. This purpose-built building includes a basic skills training kitchen, a commercial kitchen and hair salon, as well as classrooms and state-of-the-art IT facilities. The building has an energy rating A and allows the Grŵp to rationalise its estate and reduce maintenance costs.



Y Ddraig Werdd Green Dragon

Yn 2013, cyrhaeddodd y Grŵp Safon Amgylcheddol uchaf y Ddraig Werdd, sef Lefel 5. Er mwyn parhau ar y lefel hon, caiff y Grŵp ei asesu bob blwyddyn ac yn 2016, llwyddodd campysau Coleg Llandrillo i gadw'r statws lefel 5. Aeth yr aseswyr ar daith o gwmpas y campysau er mwyn gwirio nad yw ein gweithgareddau'n niweidio'r amgylchedd a'n bod yn gwella'n hól troed amgylcheddol yn barhaus mewn perthynas â gwastraff, ailgylchu a defnyddio ynni a dŵr.

The Grŵp achieved the highest level 5 of Green Dragon Environmental Standard in 2013. In order to retain this level, the Grŵp is assessed annually and in 2016, Coleg Llandrillo campuses successfully retained the level 5 award. The assessors toured the campuses to check that our activities do not cause damage to the environment and that we are continually improving our environmental footprint in regards to waste and recycling & energy and water usage.



Wi-Fi

Fis Ionawr 2016, dechreuwyd ar y gwaith a'r buddsoddiad sylwedol o sefydlu isadeiledd Wi-Fi arloesol y gellir ychwanegu ato. Drwy gyflwyno'r ddarpariaeth hon yn raddol i rannau allweddol ledled safleoedd y Grŵp, sicrhir perfformiad ardderchog a gwasanaethau rhwngryw llawn i ddefnyddwyr ar eu dyfeisiau personol ac ar galededd a ddarparir gan y Grŵp. Bydd y gwaith o ehangu'r ddarpariaeth Wi-Fi'n parhau yn ystod 2017. Ar gyfartaedd, mae 4,000 y dydd yn cysylltu â'r Wi-Fi ar yr un pryd.

Significant work and major investment started in January 2016, to implement a scalable leading-edge Wi-Fi infrastructure. The rollout to key areas across all Grŵp sites provides excellent performance and full internet services to users on personal devices and Grŵp-provided hardware. Expansion will continue during 2017 to further increase Wi-Fi coverage. Average daily concurrent Wi-Fi connections is currently 4,000.



Yn yr Arolwg Cenedlaethol o Fyfyrwyr, a gasglodd farn dros dri chan mil o fyfyrwyr ac a gomisiynir gan y Cyngor Cyllico Addysgu Uwch, daeth y Grŵp yn uwch na 7 o'r 8 prifysgol sydd yng Nghymru, ac yn drydydd o blith yr 17 coleg a phrifysgol sydd yng Nghymru, o ran bodlonrwydd myfyrwyr sy'n dilyn cyrsiau gradd.

Dim ond 1% oedd rhwng cyfradd bodlonrwydd myfyrwyr y Grŵp, sef 91%, a chyfradd bodlonrwydd myfyrwyr Prifysgol Aberystwyth a ddaeth i'r brig, ac roedd sgôr y Grŵp 8% yn uwch na ffigwr 2015, sef 83%.

The National Student Survey (NSS) of nearly a third of a million students, commissioned by the Higher Education Funding Council, ranked the Grŵp above 7 out of the 8 Welsh universities, coming in third place out of all 17 colleges and universities in Wales in terms of university level student satisfaction ratings.

The Grŵp's student satisfaction rating of 91% was only 1% behind top-placed Aberystwyth University, up 8% on 2015's figure of 83%.

The generation of cash surpluses allows investment in the Grŵp's facilities. In 2015/16 we have seen investment in the Canolfan Cefni building on Anglesey, a brand new state-of-the-art Pig Unit for the farm at Glynllifon and the rollout of improved Wi-Fi across the Grŵp's estate.

The statutory accounts for 2015/16 show a deficit position of £2.6m after adjustments for FRS102 pension costs (£1.9m) and exceptional items relating to a clawback of the FE recurrent grant for 2014/15 (£1.3m) and staff restructuring costs (£0.44m).



The Grŵp maintains a robust system of financial controls and the benchmarking performed by the Grŵp's internal auditors show that we compare favourably across the sector.


